Registration Procedure

Parents need to register their daughter for an entrance examination by calling the Admissions Office at (514) 937-2845. The date will be confirmed when the completed application form and documents are received.

The completed application form is required by the school at least five (5) working days prior to the entrance examination, along with the following documents:

- A copy of the applicant's birth certificate indicating the names of the child.
- A copy of the certificate of eligibility for English instruction.
- A copy of report cards of the last two years.
- A copy of the current report card, if available.
- A cheque to cover the application fee of \$50.

Please Note

The original birth certificate and the original certificate of eligibility for English instruction must be brought to the school on the day of the entrance examination.

- The applicant writes the entrance examination.
- The Admissions Committee reviews the application and supporting documents, as well as the entrance examination results and interviews. The parents and applicant are informed of the decision by mail.
- Parents need to notify the school of their decision within two weeks of acceptance. A non-refundable deposit of \$200, to reserve a place for their daughter, is due at that time.

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Admissions & Fees

The Day of the Entrance Examination

The entrance examination tests verbal and mathematical skills as well as a general ability to do high school work. One portion of the examination can be taken in French (Secondary I only), if desired.

Applicants and parents should arrive at the School by 8:15 a.m.

Parents must bring the original of both the applicant's birth certificate and the certificate of eligibility for English instruction. By law, the School must retain copies of each of these documents on file. A copy of the latest available report card is also required.

Girls need two HB pencils and a good eraser; calculators are not permitted during the test.

The entrance examination begins at 8:30 a.m. and usually lasts three hours.

While the examination is taking place, parents are interviewed by a member of the administration and are offered a tour of the School.

Refreshments are served. Applicants join our students in the dining room for lunch.

After lunch, applicants meet with a member of the administration. All candidates are ready to leave by approximately 2:00 p.m.
