# CITY HOUSE FOUNDATION

## Background

Established in 1981 through the joint efforts of the Parents' Guild (formerly known as the Mothers' Guild), the Advisory Council (formerly known as the Advisory Board) and the Society of the Sacred Heart (Canada), the City House Foundation is a non-profit organization with the purpose of providing financial support to the Sacred Heart School of Montreal. The trustees of the Foundation support an annual program to raise funds to be retained and invested. **The 2021-2022 objective of bursaries was \$400,000. Funds are also raised for building improvements and enrichment programs.**

## Bursaries

The Sacred Heart School of Montreal believes strongly in encouraging the development of a diverse community and is committed to attracting exceptional young women who are mission appropriate. As a result, needs-based financial aid is available to all domestic students applying to Secondary I through V. Eligibility is assessed through a third-party organization, FAST.

***For the 2021-2022 academic year - \$400,000 was awarded to 51 students. This represents 22 percent of the student population.***

The financial aid is funded by the City House Foundation, thanks to the generous support of alumnae, parents, past parents, faculty, staff and our community. Special fundraising initiatives such as the gala, golf tournament, comedy night, student initiatives, email and direct mail appeals contribute to the fundraising efforts.

The contribution to bursaries continues to be a great need: \$200,000 was donated to the school for this cause.

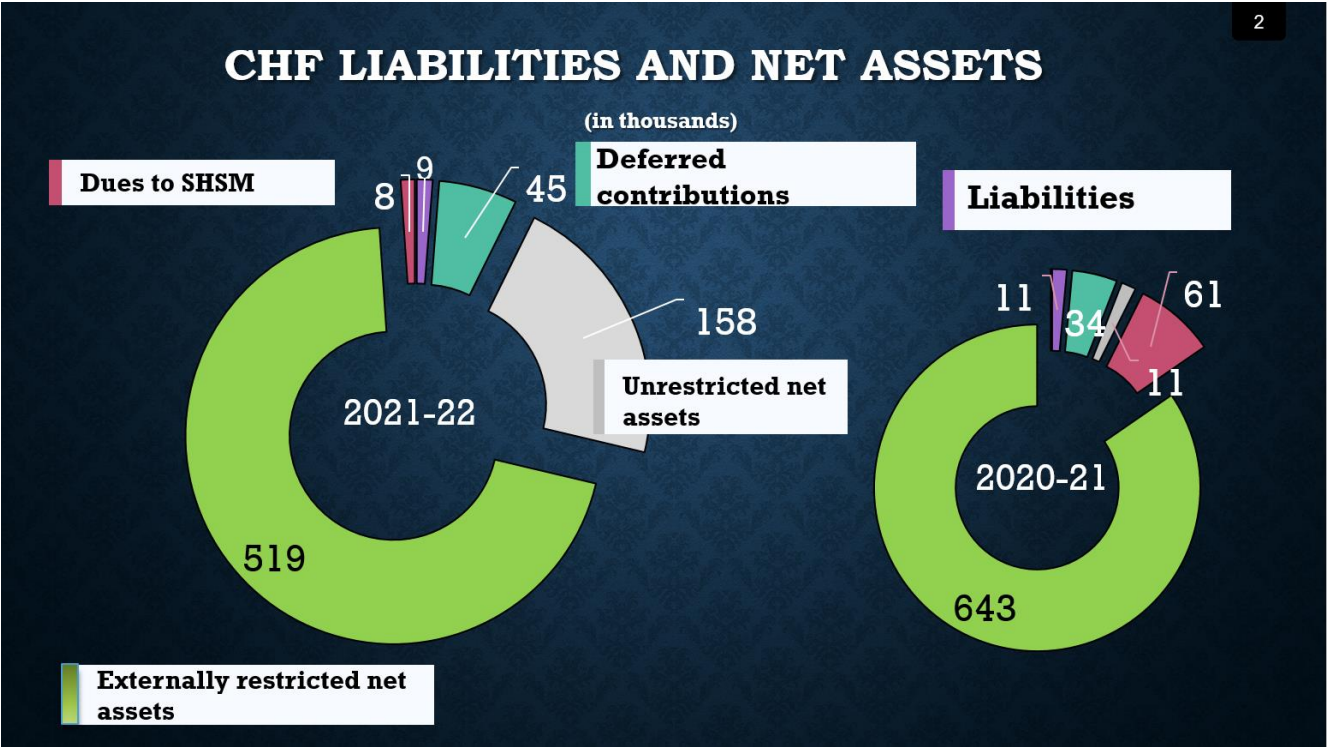
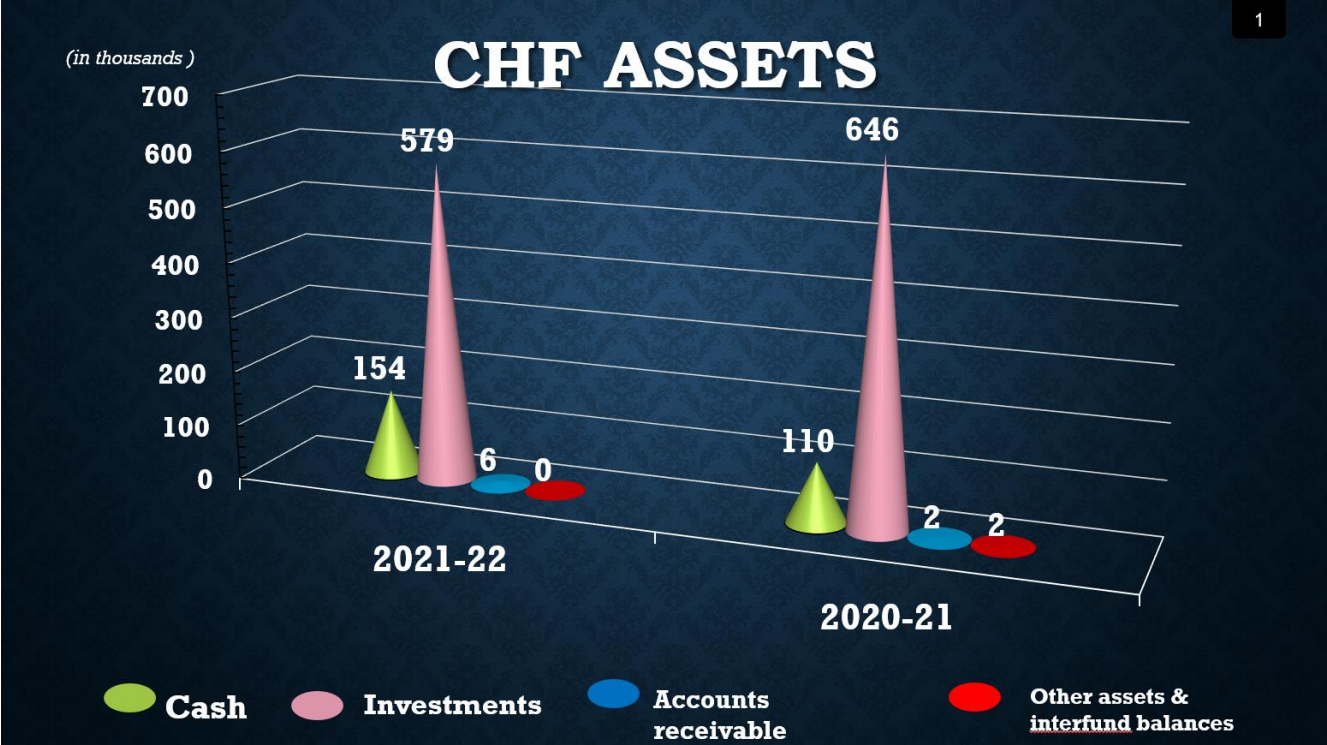
City House Foundation recorded combined gross revenue of \$835,000 from Annual Appeal and the fundraising events, which exceeded the amount from the prior year.

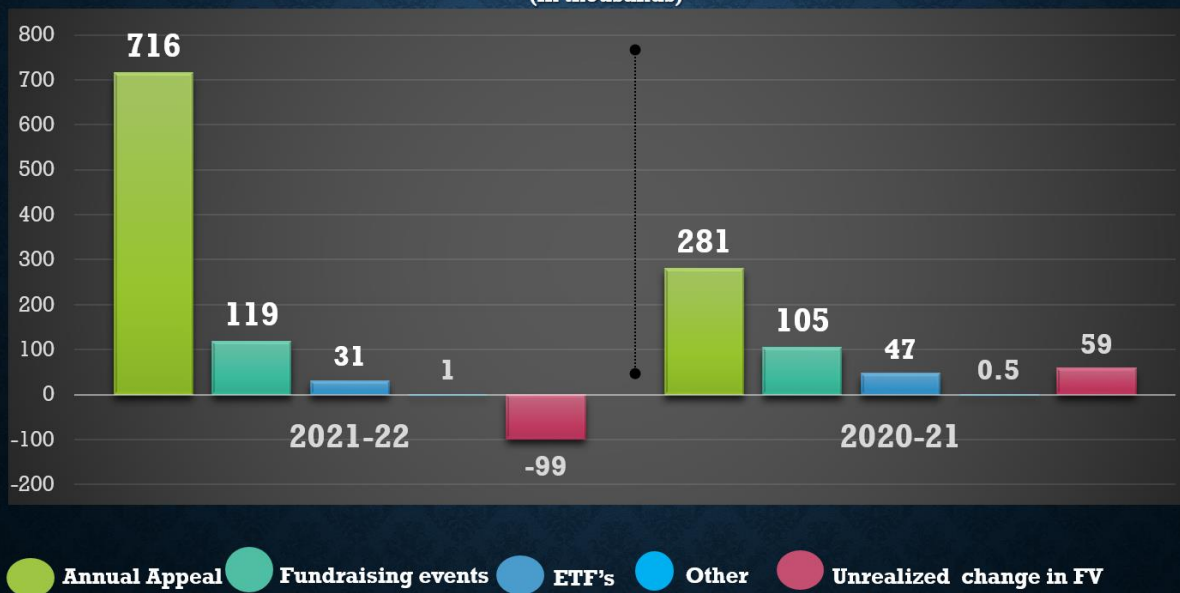

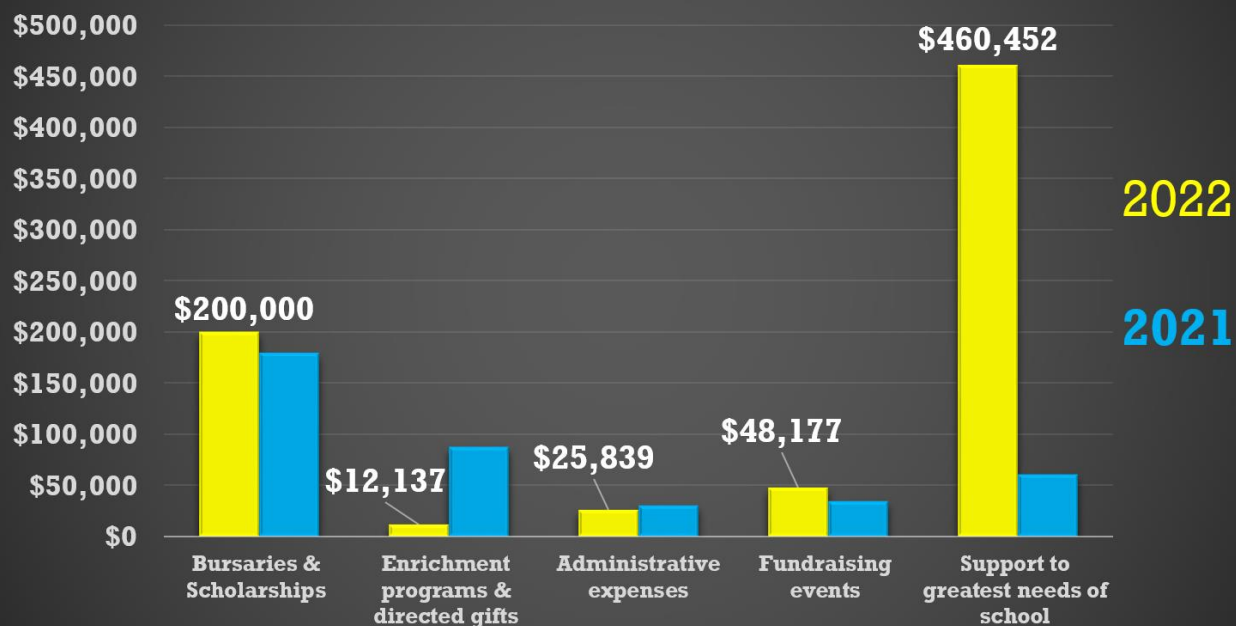


## CHF REVENUE COMPARISON

(in thousands)



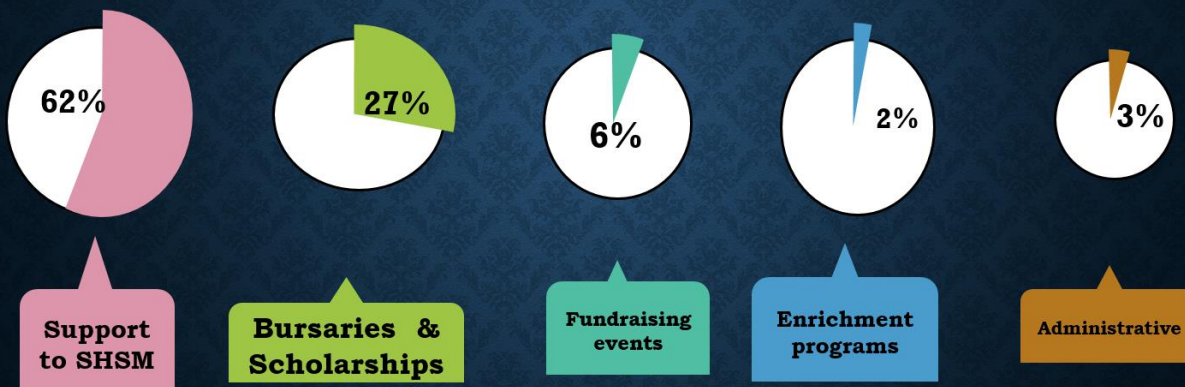
## CHF Expenditure Comparison
